Care Net Pregnancy Center of Central Texas Opening Guesthouse for New and Expectant Homeless Mothers

Waco, Texas (May 9, 2016) — Care Net Pregnancy Center of Central Texas opens its 14,000 sq. ft. facility to serve new and expectant mothers and their children with support services, along with a 28 bed facility with extended stay accommodations for those facing homelessness May 10, 2016 with an 11:30 am ribbon-cutting ceremony at 800 W. Waco Drive, Waco, TX.

The primary services provided by Care Net are pregnancy tests, ultrasounds, counseling, case management, parenting and life-skills classes, baby/maternity supplies, and housing during and after pregnancy. Care Net services are free of charge, thanks to donations from the community.

“We are working to get the word out to the community that never again will a woman facing a crisis pregnancy choose to terminate that pregnancy due to the issue of homelessness. Whether she needs a night, or a few months to get on her feet, the supporters of Care Net stand with her,” Deborah McGregor, Chief Executive Officer of Care Net.

Care Net serves over 3,000 women a year, of all ages, races and of all socio-economic backgrounds. Typically, a woman seeking our services is afraid she's pregnant, and does not (or fears she may not) have the support she needs to make a rational decision given the crisis she is in. We work to de-escalate her anxiety, and serve her so she can make an informed decision for her and her baby's future.
